

Art Work for Weeks 1 and 2

Kindergarten

- 1: Draw a costume from your favorite movie.
- 2: Draw an outside scene.

First Grade:

- 1: Draw me a picture of something holding balloons. Color your balloons in an AB pattern.
- 2: Draw a scene you would see at the zoo.

Second Grade:

- 1: Use zigzag, dotted, and wavy lines in a drawing.
- 2: Draw a scene where the sun is setting.

Third Grade:

- 1: Create an original artwork of either your family (in your house) or your favorite sports team. (No stick people.)
- 2: Create an environmental piece of art. (Use something unusual from home to create a piece of art. Examples include: plastic bottle, crushed aluminum can, toilet paper roll...be creative!

Fourth Grade:

- 1: Pretend you are running for President. You need to create an example of graphic art (a poster or advertisement for your campaign). (Poster/advertisement-can just be a normal piece of paper.)
- 2: Create an environmental piece of art. (Use something unusual from home to create a piece of art. Examples include: plastic bottle, crushed aluminum can, toilet paper roll...be creative!

Fifth Grade:

- 1: Draw a realistic human face. Make sure eyes, nose, and mouth are all proportionate. You can cover up ears with hair if you wish, or you can attempt to draw ears.
- 2: Create an environmental piece of art. (Use something unusual from home to create a piece of art. Examples include: plastic bottle, crushed aluminum can, toilet paper roll...be creative!
